1. Entries will be received Tuesday, July 22nd from 2:00-3:00 p.m. in the Rotary Building. Please complete entry form listing all items you are entering.
2. All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor.
3. Each article will be under the control of the chairpersons and the Fair and every precaution will be taken to prevent damages, but in no event will the Fair be responsible for injury or loss that may occur.
4. No exhibitor may enter more than one entry in any one class, and no one article may be entered in more than one class.
5. No collections of items may be entered.
6. All baked goods should be exhibited on sturdy foam plates or neat cardboard squares and covered securely with clear wrap.
7. An individually wrapped sample is needed for tasting and should be attached to the outside of the entry.
8. All miscellaneous food items should include an attached recipe.
9. All entries must remain in place until check out on Tuesday, July 22nd from 8:00-10:00 p.m.

### Guidelines for Preserved Food

1. All canned goods must be in standard clear, colorless glass canning jars, sealed with two-piece lids using appropriate heat processing. Paraffin is not an acceptable seal. Band should be in place for transporting jars, but will be removed for judging. The jar must have a plain label and no additional decoration.
2. Entries must be labeled with product name, date of preparation, processing method and length of processing time, and source of recipe. Entries with incomplete labels will be disqualified.
3. All foods must be canned according to 1989 or later USDA, Ball or Kerr guidelines.
4. Any sign of spoilage or alteration from standard processing guidelines will be basis for disqualification of the entry.
