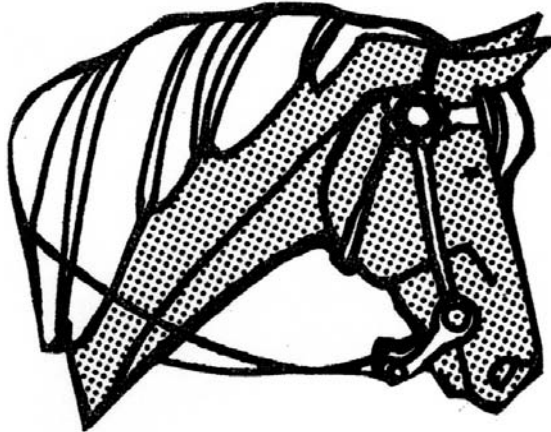

RULES

1. 1st Place trophies in each class. 1st through 6th ribbons.
2. **Current negative coggins is required** for all horses showing or entering the Pike County Fairgrounds for all show events - **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
3. All entry forms must be signed. Youth forms must be signed by the parent or Guardian - who must remain on the show grounds during the entire show.
4. Proper attire is required for ALL classes, Western and Gaited.
5. Age of Youth Riders is 17 years and under as of January 1, 2011 and Adult Riders is 18 years and older.
6. Entries will close one class prior to class currently in arena, **except classes 7, 12, 14 & 16. These class entries will close three (3) classes prior because of cash prizes.**
7. All entries shall enter the ring promptly when class is called.
8. All horses will be properly controlled at all times, both in and out of the arena, and will not be ridden to the endangerment of anyone and must be properly trained for the classes entered. Exhibitor assumes all risk of injury. Each minor and adult will be required to sign a release, with the parent or guardian signing for the minor.
